

Dr. John Carpenter earns dental diplomate status

F. Carpenter of New Windsor has earned diplomate status in the International Congress of Oral Implantologists at Columbia University's College of Dental Medicine. According to the ICOI, the awarding of diplomate status is the highest honor the organization bestows on a dental professional involved in implant treatment. Diplomate candidates must document at least 60 completed implant cases. These cases must include at least 200 individual implants, be a minimum of 5 years old and use advanced implant procedures and techniques. They must also lecture at dental meetings and write implantology articles. Carpenter has written several articles appearing in implant dentistry journals and has lectured both nationally and internationally. All ICOI diplomates may choose to list the designation "DICOI" after their names. The ICOI is a worldwide dental educational organization dedicated to communicating scientific knowledge and improving the clinical practice of dental implantology.
